- The number of churches engaged in shared case management, joint events and drives is not adequate in most cities to warrant technology to coordinate

So Now We're Launching an Exciting New Initiative...

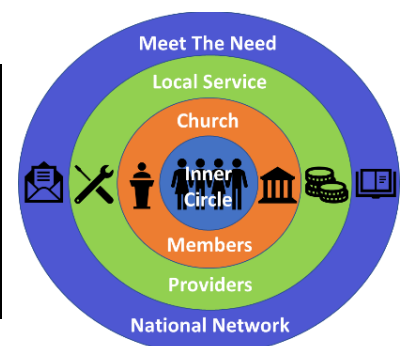
- Accommodating these trends and an aging code base by revamping and modernizing our core systems
